



CITY OF TOLEDO, DIVISION OF SOLID WASTE REFUSE RULES

- Do not overfill the container. Objects should not protrude beyond the top of the container and the lid must close securely
- Place the container with the lid opening facing the street or alley and the wheels toward the house
- Place container at least three feet from parked vehicles and three feet from obstructions such as mailboxes and other containers
- Do not place containers under trees, wires or basketball hoops
- Place container within one foot of the curb or alley line
- Refuse must be out for collection by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day



- Containers must be removed within 24 hours of your collection
- Do not wedge your refuse inside the container too tightly as it may not empty completely into the truck
- Do not place hazardous materials such as paint, batteries, oil, or chemicals into your containers
- You are allowed to purchase one additional container for either refuse or recycling
- Holiday trees will not be collected. They are to be recycled at a recycling center or designated drop off location
- Refuse collection is designed for residential service of four units and under and some small businesses
- The container weight shall not exceed the weight identified on the container



BULK ITEM RULES

- Must call by 4 p.m. 2 business days (48 hours) before your scheduled collection
- Households are limited to once per quarter for this type of collection
- Residents requesting additional collection of this method will be charged \$50 per request

Acceptable Items:

- Loose items of five (5) or more such as lumber, brush, etc. are to be tied in bundles not exceeding six (6) feet in length and two (2) feet in diameter and not weighing more than 40 lbs.
- Rugs/carpet must be rolled and tied at both ends and be no longer than six feet in length
- Couches, furniture, large TV's, etc.

Prohibited Items:

- No tires
- No hazardous waste (oil, paint, chemicals)
- No building or construction material from commercial work
- No major automobile components
- No white-ware items such as stoves, refrigerators, hot water tanks, washers and dryers
