DISCOVERY NOTICE AS TO KEITH JUNIOR TRIPLETT

If the defendant makes a general request for discovery the government will construe it as a request for each item described in Fed. R. Crim. P. 16(a)(1) (A)-(E). The government's compliance with the defendant's general request will trigger the defendant's duty to provide reciprocal discovery of each item specified in Fed. R. Crim. P. 16(b)(1)(A)-(C).
